



Male Soldiers may have a mustache . . .

In accordance with AR 670-1, *Wear and Appearance of Army Uniforms and Insignia, para 1-8a(2)(c), Feb 05*

The mustache must present a neatly trimmed, tapered, and tidy appearance, but must not cover the upper lip line, and may not exceed sideways beyond a vertical line drawn upward from the corners of the mouth.

If profiled for shaving you must keep it trimmed to the specified length. You cannot shape the growth into goatees, or “Fu Manchu” or handlebar mustaches.

The AR does not contain a provision for Soldiers who claim that their civilian job requires a mustache that is not in compliance with this standard.
